Mr. Hardeman began the discussion with a handout of the principals' priority need list. The American Disability Act compliance review has been completed on Loyalton High School and the Downieville schools.

Discussion: Changes to be made for compliance.

Ms. Karen Copsey, architect, will be meeting with Stan Hardeman and Rose Asquith, pro bono, to review the schools and possible projects.

A cost comparison reveals that the marketing bond consultant, bonding agent, legal services and polling administrator are all competitively priced. A beginning estimate for out of pocket expenses is \$40,000 (polling, marketing, legal services).

Discussion: Eligibility for matching funds from the State, Pros and cons of borrowing 1.5 million to receive matching funds from state.

An investment of \$50,000 may be required to go for a bond which, if failed, could qualify us for hardship status. Pursuing a loan may remove us from hardship status.

A district under hardship status receives 60% from the state. A district under extreme hardship status receives 80%.

What we need to do:

Invest \$24,000 to:

Find out financial feasibility before proceeding.

Present our situation to the community.

It was suggested to have a facility master plan.
