SIERRA-PLUMAS JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. 14-001

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY WHICH THEREBY SUSPENDS THE NORMAL BID REQUIREMENTS

LOYALTON HIGH SCHOOL PAVING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of Sierra-Plumas Joint Unified School District (S-PJUSD) on May 14, 2014, did award the bid to McCuen Construction, Inc., for the Loyalton High School Paving Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, per Public Contract Code 3400(b)(4), it is necessary for the S-PJUSD Governing Board to declare an emergency due to the following substantial evidence: Excavation revealed soft, unstable base soil resulting in additional change orders. Going out to bid would result in interference with the beginning of the school year and creating unsafe conditions for staff and students as the ingress and egress to the school site is jeopardized; and

WHEREAS, the S-PJUSD Governing Board states that based on the substantial evidence the emergency will not permit a delay resulting from calling for bids and the action is necessary to respond to the emergency; and

WHEREAS, the facts setting forth the reasons for finding an emergency will be contained in the board minutes; and

WHEREAS, per Public Contract Code 3400(b)(4) and the declaration of an emergency due to the above mentioned substantial evidence, the normal bid requirements may be suspended; and

WHEREAS, per Public Contract Code 22050, the S-PJUSD Governing Board will continually review the emergency action at subsequent meetings until the board determines that the emergency no longer exists; and

WHEREAS, Education Code 20113(a)(1) allows the board, by unanimous vote with approval of the county superintendent, to enter into a contract to make repairs without soliciting bids; and

THEREFORE, the S-PJUSD Governing Board hereby declares an emergency in regards to the Loyalton High School Paving Project due to the above substantial evidence and that normal bid requirements are suspended.






